Here's to a summer full of golf, growth, and great times at both clubs!

Golf Tip of the Month

Let's keep it simple: **check your hip movement.**Ask a friend to watch your backswing and note if your right hip sways to the right. If it does, you're setting yourself up for inconsistency – and possibly frustration. This common flaw is the root cause of many swing issues. Instead, take a cue from Rory McIlroy. Notice how his right hip shifts back and slightly left during his takeaway – a much more powerful and stable move.

Not sure how to correct it? Your golf professionals, **John Ward** and **Eric Radcliffe**, have a variety of easy-to-follow drills to help break this habit. Stop by either golf shop – let's fix it before it wrecks your game.

And with summer heat in full swing, here's an equally important reminder: **hydrate!**

You can't play your best golf – or stay safe – if you're dehydrated. Drink water before, during, and after your round. Pair it with a light, healthy breakfast to keep your energy up and your mind sharp.

Play smart. Stay safe. Swing better.



"Let the Spirit of the Game Guide You"

Course conditions are improving every day – let's all do our part to keep the momentum going.

We've noticed continued issues with golf carts being driven too close to tees and greens. As a reminder, carts should remain at least **20 feet** (**about 7 steps**) away from any putting surface. That's a basic rule of course etiquette and critical to maintaining turf quality in these high-traffic areas.


Please follow the **90-Degree Rule:**

Stay on the cart path until you're even with your ball, then turn at a right angle to reach it. When near tees and greens, all **four tires must remain on the cart path**. This is especially important as turf continues to recover and fill in.

Golfers with legitimate handicap flags may access greens from **behind**, but **never in front or along the sides**, as these areas are meant to stay playable and healthy.

To help ensure compliance – particularly with afternoon non-member play – our staff will be conducting additional Ranger patrols.

Thank you for honoring the spirit of the game and helping protect the course we all enjoy.


SUGARMILL WOODS GOLF COURSE SUPERINTENDENT

Over at Sugarmill Woods, Mike and his team have just completed the spring fertilizer application, aerified the fairways, and taken another pass at weed control. And have you seen those back-nine **Zoysia greens** lately? They're finally perking up – and looking better every week.

Following the expert advice of the University of Florida's Agronomic Services, we've adjusted our approach: **less fertilizer, more water**, and an increase in **verticutting and topdressing**. This combination is already paying off. With consistent care and summer growth ahead, those greens are set to thrive.

As always, we ask for your help in keeping the course in great shape. Please **place rakes inside bunkers** after use, follow the **90-degree rule**, and keep carts in the rough or on paths whenever possible. Your cooperation is appreciated!

Let the debate begin! Mathew, Andy, and John recently found themselves in a friendly argument over which fairway has shown the most improvement. Mathew voted for #3, Andy backed #10, and John was all-in on #5. But after some healthy discussion, the consensus might just be a tie between #2 and #12 – and that's a great problem to have! **The Great Golf Course Resurrection of 2025** is well underway, and the progress is undeniable. Even the tee boxes are filling in beautifully. With a couple more greens scheduled for sod, we'll be "off to the races."

To help protect all this progress, we've implemented a new **Flag Program** for golf carts. Red flags have been placed along each cart path to mark designated fairway entry points. Please remain on the path until you reach the red flag, then proceed at a 90-degree angle. These flags will move as conditions change – generally 50 to 100 yards past the forward tees. We welcome your feedback as we fine-tune this program.

In addition to ongoing summer maintenance, we're staying busy with tree trimming, weed control, course clean-up, and fresh landscaping around the clubhouse. The future is looking bright at Citrus National!
