Three Tips for Your Best Putting Stroke:

- Aim the putter face well. Where you aim your putter face has to be a huge priority if you want to make your short putts, because the ball will travel where your putter face is pointed at impact. Yes, your path influences it, but the putter face is king. You can see good players do it in their pre-putt routine: After their practice strokes, they take a moment to aim the putter face before settling into that grip and setup.
- Get a grip. The way you place your hands on your putter's grip will stabilize the club and influence your ability to deliver a square face at impact.

 There are so many ways to hold a putter, so you have plenty of choices. I'd suggest using whatever makes you feel most coordinated, and if you're looking for something basic, take your cues from the grip's design. Most grips have a flat top. Place your thumbs on the flat portion, and because the club is more upright, it's designed to be held more in your palms than your other clubs, which will eliminate excessive wrist movement.

• **Good posture.** Good posture, where you bow forward from your hips and let your arms hang below your shoulders, creates a natural path for your arms to swing. You can practice this without your putter: Bow forward from your hips, clap your hands together and allow your arms to swing naturally. Your stance width can vary according to preference, but generally, it should be roughly the width of your hips.

Our Sugarmill crew continues to achieve steady progress as the course has been described as in the best shape it's been "in the last 8 years". We have been staying aggressive with a few pesky weeds on the back nine with aerifying and verticutting happening often. The zoysia greens on the back nine love regular verticutting as it promotes more growth. Weed control continues to be a priority which is improved from last year at this time. We continue to push to create "Country Club Quality" as we strive to bring this course back.

Citrus National Golf Club is benefitting from the steady progress we have made as we have spent the last two months repairing the Citrus irrigation system, which had suffered at the hands of years of neglect. Thousands of feet of new hydraulic lines have been laid, which has

enabled us to gain control of the roque sprinkler heads so that we can water in the proper and consistent manner needed to grow turfgrass. New equipment has enabled us to more efficiently improve the course conditions, along with a fertilizer and herbicide program we have implemented. We continue to see improvement in the course daily and will continue to push to continue this momentum.

Pickleball and Tennis Court Reservations

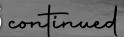
With the increased activities you may want to use the court reservation system that is in place for both pickleball and tennis. The pickleball court reservation clipboard is hanging in a weather protected area of the middle pavilion by the pickleball courts. The tennis reservation clipboard is located in the pro shop/fitness area on the blue counter. Please use PENCIL only when reserving your court and follow the reservation rules.

Reservation Rules:

A) A tennis or pickleball court may be reserved up to fourteen (14) days in advance. No court reservations may be scheduled in consecutive time periods by the same member, family, or group. The maximum number of courts that may be reserved by a single member is two (2). Cancellations should be made as soon as possible. Failure to show up within 10 minutes of your reserved time will result in forfeiture of that reservation.

- B) Doubles may reserve no more than a 2-hour block of time. Doubles are two players on each side. It can also be Canadian/Australian/Cut Throat doubles, which are two on one side and one on the other side.
- C) Singles, one on each side, may reserve no more than a 1 hour segment of time.
- D) All reservations need to start on either the full hour or the half hour.
- E) Reservations have preference at all times. Players not having reservations must promptly give way to those who do.
- F) A member with or without a reservation, who has not played, has priority over members who have played.
 G) All authorized club mixers, tournaments, special events and club leagues, have priority over general play. These events will be scheduled and posted.

H) Two (2) courts are set aside for the Oak Village Sports Complex (OVSC) staff tennis and pickleball teaching professional for instruction and clinics. The OVSC Teaching professional has exclusive rights to tennis and pickleball instruction, league play and tournaments. I) All forms of organized tennis or pickleball play must first be approved by the Director of Racquet Sports before scheduling. This would include playdays, leagues, and special events and must have advance notification so interested and qualifying members can participate.

J) The court reservations sheets will be clearly available at the OVSC Pickleball Pavilion and/or the OVSC Pro Shop/Fitness Center/Office.

How to Make a Reservation:

The Reservation Board will house the tennis and pickleball reservation sheets. This board will be found on top of the blue counter in the OVSC office/fitness area or the OVSC Bulletin Board.

Please use PENCIL. (No ink or markers)

- Place an "X" across the time and court you wish to reserve.
- Write in each player's name. All names must be actual players. You may not reserve a court using "not for certain" players. In other words, all players listed must be available to play.

These rules and regulations are also posted on the bulletin board outside the Pro Shop/Fitness Center/Office. Reservations are not required but are recommended during prime time at the courts.

REMEMBER....all players must be members of OVSC. Members are responsible to report all non-member guests and pay the required guest fee.

Pickleball Day Dinkers, Family Fun and Social

Mornings have 6 courts automatically reserved for the open club mixers. 2 Courts are left unreserved for those who do not want to participate in the mixers...they in turn may reserve the courts under their names. IF they are not reserved, the courts become open for overflow of morning mixer play.

Stroke of the Week Pickleball Clinic has courts #1 and #2 reserved every Friday, 10:30 to 11:30AM.

Tennis Men's and Ladies Day, FUN-sters, Ladies Inter-club League Competition play are all automatically reserved.

Men's Day Tennis is every Monday, Wednesday and Saturday, 8:30AM to 10:30AM on Courts #1 and #2.

Ladies Day Tennis is every Tuesday and Thursday, 8:30AM to 10:30AM on Courts #1 and #2.

FUN-sters Mix Doubles is every Friday, 8:30AM to 10:30AM on Courts #1 and #2

Ladies Inter-Club League will play on provided scheduled Tuesday home matches. Check the reservation sheets each week for open courts.

Ladies Inter-Club Thursday League will play from 10:00AM to Noon on scheduled home matches, using courts #1, 2, 3 and 4. Check the reservation sheets each week for open courts.

Preventing Pickleball Injuries

Pickleball is now the fastest growing sport in the country according to USA Pickleball, the governing body for the sport in the US. Pickleball provides a great physical workout and beneficial social outlet to folks of all ages. Because of the increasing participation. doctors are seeing a larger amount of pickleball-related injuries such as sprains, strains, fractures, etc. While it would not be possible to make pickleball, or any activity for that matter, injury free, you can be smart and do things to lower your chances of getting hurt on the pickleball court.

Recognize your physical limitations. There is such a wide variety of people that are playing pickleball that we'd expect different levels of physical fitness. Some pickleball players exercise religiously while some only get the activity of the weekend games. You know which end of the spectrum you belong to so start slowly. Listen to your body, especially if you've had previous knee, ankle, or wrist injuries. Add more games as you progress and don't be afraid to use knee, ankle, or wrist braces or compression sleeves as needed.

Take time to warm up sufficiently. Give yourself time to warm up before you begin playing. Develop a warm-up routine that gets the heart going such as a light jog, jumping jacks or even a quick walk around the courts. Try to stretch the major muscle groups including calves, guads, hamstrings, lower back, and shoulders. You should be able to get a complete and sufficient warm up completed in 10-15 minutes so it won't interfere with playing time.

Start Slowly. Start slowly with both your warm-up routine and the amount of time you spend on the court. Unless you are in top shape, don't overdo it when you begin your pickleball journey. Instead, gradually increase the time you spend on the court and rest well between games. As you play longer your recovery time will improve and you'll get more games in.

Use the correct equipment. The shoes you pick are very important, so leave the running shoes and athletic shoes at home. Pickleball requires a lot of lateral movement along with forward and backward lunging

and court shoes are made for this. Since we have outdoor courts here in Sugarmill, pick outdoor tennis or pickleball shoes. Make sure your pickleball shoes fit well and provide stability needed for your ankles. Shoes that are too big invite rolled ankles and tripping injuries.

Paddles are another important consideration. If you've had tennis elbow in the past, or you get it after you start playing pickleball, talk to our pro about changing your handle size. New grips and overgrips can help provide comfort to your tennis elbow.

Hydrate. During any extended physical efforts in hot weather, dehydration can consume up to 2-3% of your weight causing muscle fatigue, dizziness, confusion, and cramping. If you plan to spend even an hour out on the courts, make sure you have enough drink to restore the liquids your body needs. While water is a great choice you should have a drink that restores lost electrolytes. Watch out for those sugary, overpriced sports drinks that are being sold. You simply add an electrolyte salt to the water you will be drinking. During the game, you can call for a hydration break or a timeout to get a drink if you need. Believe me, everybody else will take advantage and get a drink as well.

Take lessons. Using proper technique when hitting the ball will reduce strain and overuse injuries. Also, learning to anticipate where you should be on the court will reduce stress while trying to reach and react to a ball out of your area. Lessons will help with these situations as your playing time and confidence increase.

So, in conclusion, be smart and warm up! See you on the Pickleball Courts. Come to lessons on Friday mornings at 10:30AM and then join one of our friendly Sugarmill Woods Pickleball groups.

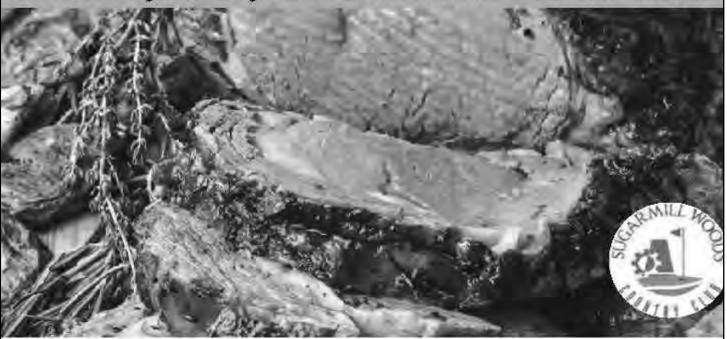
